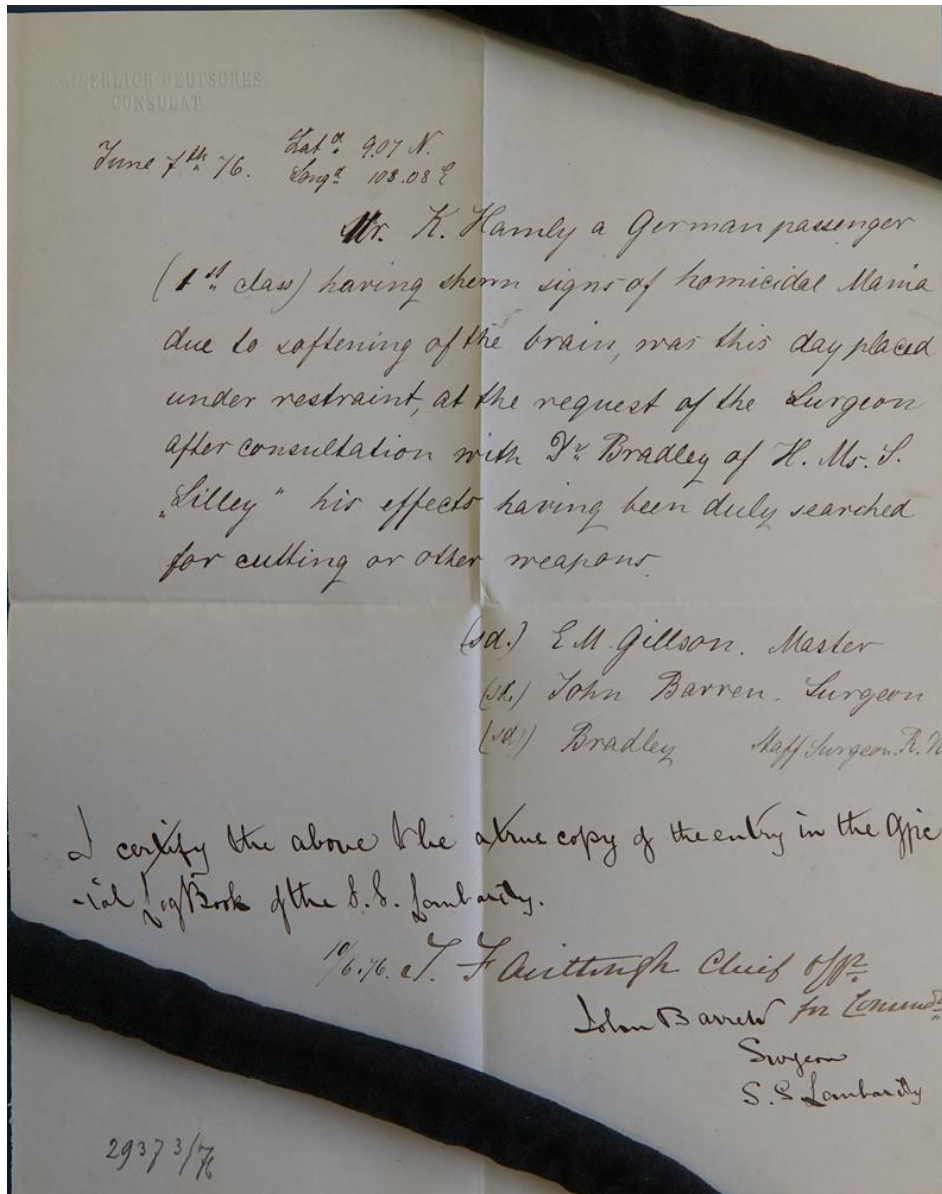


Logbucheintrag der P&O S. S. Lombardy vom 7. Juni 1876 Faksimile der Abschrift und Transkript

June 7th 76. Latd. 9.07 N.

Mr. K. Hamly [sic!], a German passenger (1st class) having shown signs of homicidal Mania due to softening of the brain, was this day placed under restraint, at the request of the Surgeon after consultation with Dr. Bradley, of H. M. S. „Lilley“ his effects having been duly searched for cutting or other weapons.
