


**Schreiben von Surgeon Barren an Konsul Bieber

Singapore, June 9th, 1876.

Singapore.

Sir,

I have the honour to

place in your charge Herr K. Hamyl [sic!] late passenger
in the P.&O. S. S. Lombardy from Hongkong
to this port.

He is suffering from Softening of the
Brain and on the morning of June 9th was
the subject of Homicidal mania; after consultation
with Dr. Bradley of H. M. S. S. Lily, I
placed him under restraint and constant
supervision, and the same was duly entered
in the official logbook.

He has now a lucid interval,
but I am unable to say from my short
experience of his case for what period
[2] he may remain so.
